Police Clearance Certificate (PCC)

Police Clearance certificate is not a Passport service. Issue of PCC is a distinct miscellaneous service rendered on behalf of Police authorities in India and does not form an integral part of the Passport service. Police Clearance Certificate (PCC) is issued by the Embassy of India, Luanda certifying the person's criminal record with the Indian police.

Note :

Please note that competent authorities in India have decided that henceforth PCC will only be issued after receipt of fresh police verification on the PCC application. This will apply to all categories of applicants. All PCC applications should be accepted only with a valid Passport and not with passport reissue applications. PCC may be applied after reissue of passport if it is due for renewal.

Applicant must note that if while applying for PCC, he/she is providing details in PCC application which are different than details available in his/her passport (such as name, place of birth, any discrepancy in parents' name, change in marital status, addition/deletion of spouse name), the applicant should instead of applying for PCC, should first apply for reissue of passport with changed/current particulars. After the reissue of passport with changed particulars, the PCC application must be submitted.

Processing Time

PCC can be issued only after receipt of a 'Clear' report from Police authorities in India which is to be made available in the system by the concerned Passport office. This process may take 6-8 weeks. PCC can be issued earlier provided a 'Clear' report is received. Please note that there is no guarantee that PCC will be issued within the indicated time frame, as it is purely related to receipt of a 'Clear' report from authorities. In view of this, applicants are requested to assess their requirements for obtaining PCC for India well in advance and submit their applications accordingly. The PCC is valid for a period of 6 months and can be

applied before if there is any expectation of its requirement for PR or renewal of work permit/study permit etc. Please note that there is no emergency PCC.

Where and Who can apply for PCC

All types of PCC applications are to be submitted online whether by Indian nationals or Angolans who have stayed in India in the Past for education, training, family reason, etc. and need Police clearance for the period of their stay.

PCC TO INDIAN NATIONALS

Such applicants have to fill up application form on line and after completing application, take a print out and submit it with required documents at the Embassy counter. The applicant should provide correct permanent/present address in India with PIN CODE, at which his/her Indian citizenship and other particulars could be verified by his/her parents or relatives, and select correct Police Station in the online system. If the applicant has doubt about the Police Station under which his permanent/present address comes, he should google it or check it with Police Authorities in India, before filling up the application.

All applicants would need to:

1. Visit the <https://embassy.passportindia.gov.in/> (Passport Seva at Indian Embassies and Consulates)
2. Complete one-time registration and create a USER ID.
3. Login using the newly created USER ID and fill in the user-friendly application form online at the same portal.
4. Complete an online registration
5. Submit the online PCC application form.
6. Take a printout of your application form.
7. Paste photo and put signatures at the designated place.

Documents to be attached for submitting the application :

- Copy of first and last page of Indian passport of the applicant.

- Copy of valid Permanent Resident Card/Work Permit/Student Permit/ long term Visa etc
- Proof of Address/Copy of the Passport of Parents/Aadhar Card or Voter ID should be submitted along with the application.
- Proof of current Angolan residence address
- Prescribed PCC Fees to be paid at Embassy counter

PCC requests of Angolan nationals including Angolans of Indian origin

Angolans or other foreigners of Indian origin who have stayed in India in the Past as they were born in India or stayed for purposes of education, training, family reason, etc. and need Police clearance for the period of their stay in India, such applicants can also submit their PCC application form

Requirements :

- Visit the <https://embassy.passportindia.gov.in/> (Passport Seva at Indian Embassies and Consulates) and complete the procedure as above.
- Copy of current Passport
- Copy of Angolan Citizenship Certificate
- Copy of Angolan passport
- Copy of last held Indian passport
- Proof of address (*as mentioned above*)
- Prescribed PCC Fees to be paid at Embassy counter

PCC for Other Foreigners who have stayed in India in the past for education, etc.

Foreigners who have stayed in India in the Past for education, training, family reason, etc and need Police clearance for the period of their stay in India, such applicants can also submit their PCC application form

Requirements:

- Visit the <https://embassy.passportindia.gov.in/> (Passport Seva at Indian Embassies and Consulates) and complete the procedure as above.

- Copy of current Passport
- Copy of previous Passport on which applicant traveled to India
- Copy of Indian visa along with Entry/Exit stamp by the Immigration.
- Proof of address (*as mentioned above*)
- Prescribed PCC Fees to be paid at Embassy counter

Caution: Applicants are advised not to submit multiple applications for PCC unless and until the previous file is closed with the issuance of PCC. Care must be taken to select correct gender, as Mr. or Ms. and son of/ daughter of is printed by the system based on entries made by the applicant in his/her PCC application, correction in such cases is not possible.
